## February 17 Children's Lesson

### The Story of David-The Death of His Son

**Objective:** The children will learn about David and how he handled the death of his son.

**Materials:** Bible, Worksheets, crayons, pencils

**Lesson:** Review over last week's lesson and how Hannah worshiped God despite the things she went through and what she gave God. Then tell the kids about Nathan and that he was a prophet. Remind the kids what a prophet is. Talk to the kids about the bad things that David had done, and that God was angry with him. Then you can read from 2 Samuel 12: 1-24. Even though God was angry and took something precious away from him David still worshiped God and God blessed him with another son.

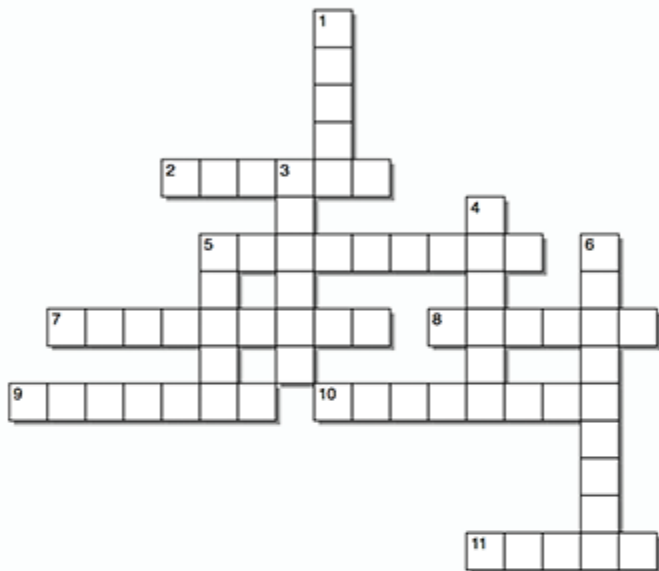
**Activity:** There are worksheets for different ages of kids you can print out which ever one they want to do.

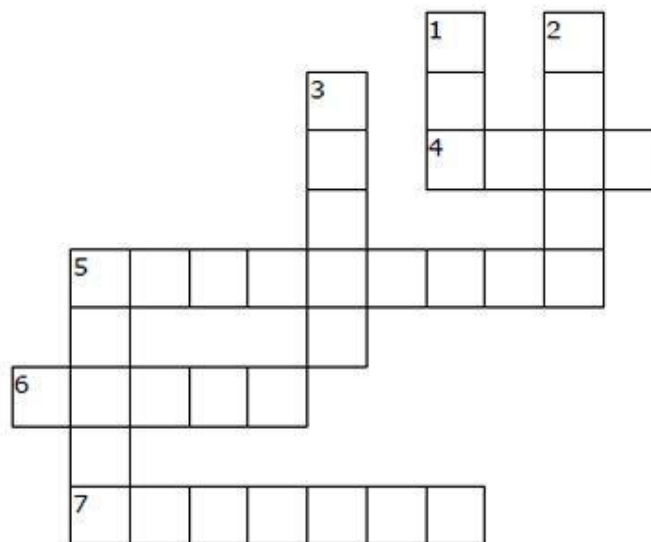
