Objective: The children will learn about Job and all the things that were taken away from him, but he never gave up on God. He still prayed and worshiped him.

Materials: Bible, Worksheets, crayons, pencils

Lesson: Review over the last couple of weeks lessons about how bad things happened but they never gave up on God. Then you can start reading from Job or you can summarize all the things taken away from him and the out poor of rewards he received from never giving up on God. Remind the kids that bad things do happen, but it makes them stronger and by worshiping God and not giving up on him, he will never leave you and will reward you in the end. We might not see it now, but we will either in this life or in heaven with him.

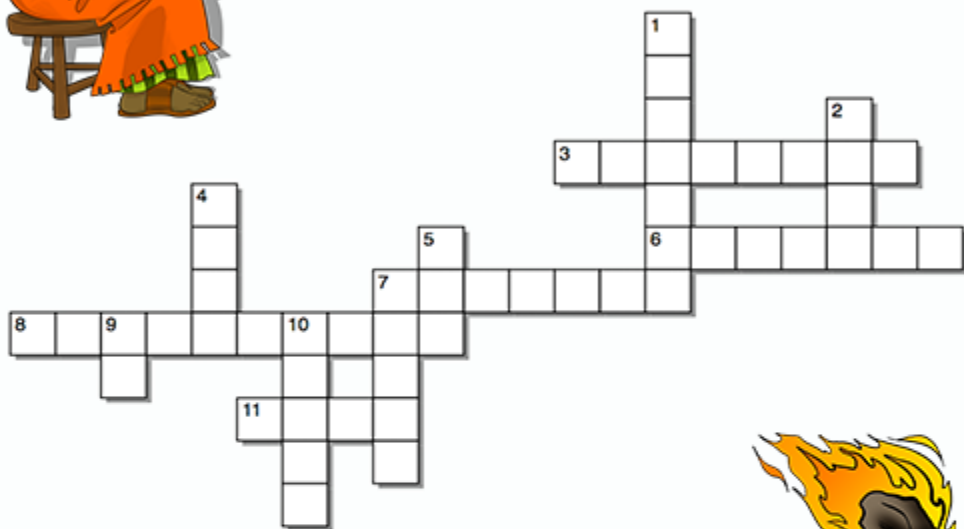

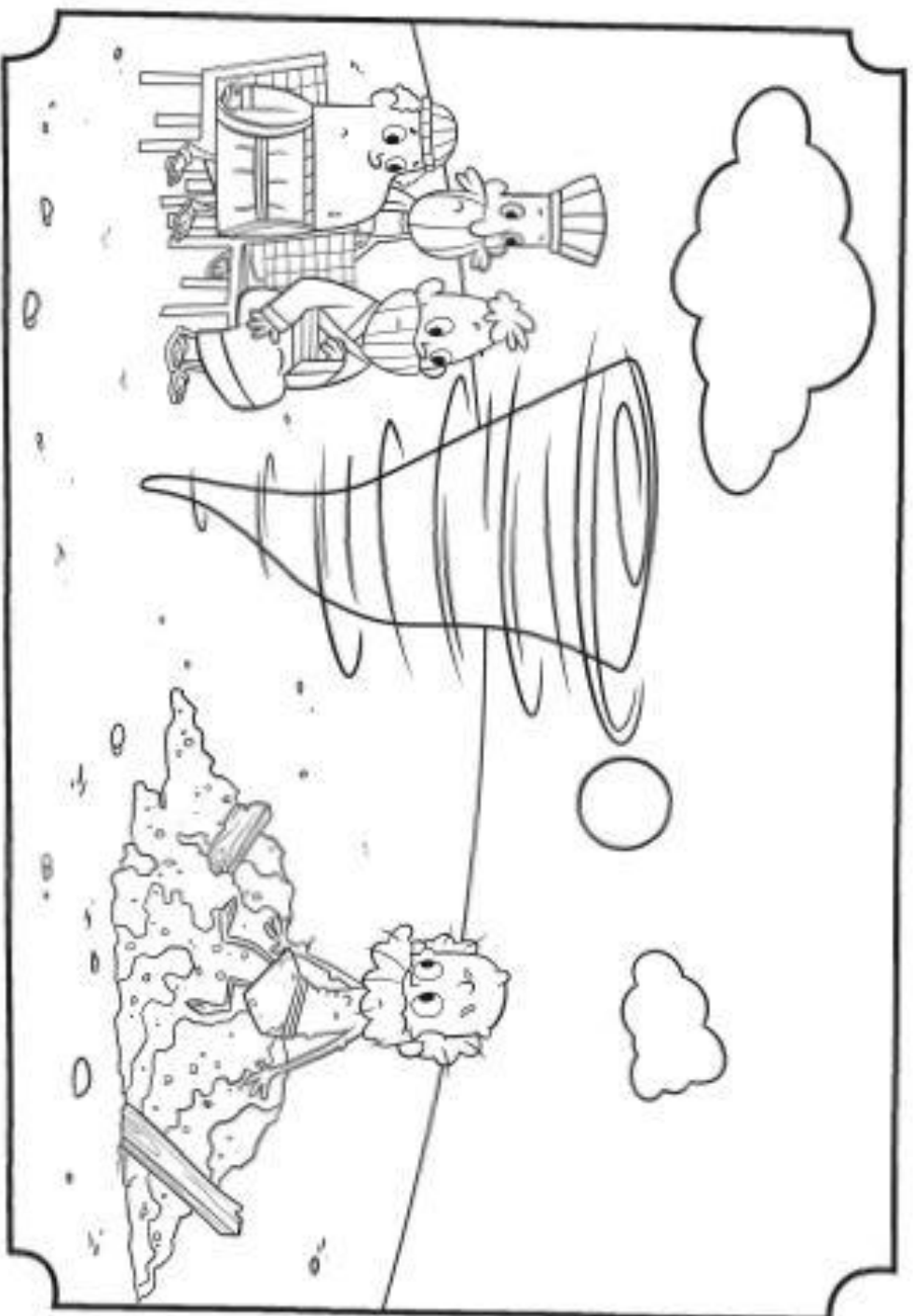
