July 14 Children's Lesson

What Harmony Means in The Bible

Objective: The children will discuss and learn what living in harmony means and what it means in the Bible.

Materials: Bible, any at home obstacles for the kids to work together to accomplish.

Lesson: Talk with the kids about what it means to live in harmony with each other. It means that we can live with each other peacefully together as one. We live with God harmoniously by believing, trusting, and following him in our every day lives. How can we all live harmoniously with God and others? You can read John 13: 34-35. Another passage to read is Philippians 2: 1-11. If we lived like Jesus did, we all would live harmoniously with one another.

Activity: Play a game with the kids on working together. Ex: make an obstacle course with cups, craft sticks, paper, and get a gummy worm. Have the kids work together to move the gummy worm across the obstacle course. They cannot use their hands but only toothpicks or craft sticks and they cannot poke the gummy. You might have to pair them off. This is just an example you can make others just as long as they work together.
