## February 2022

As we continue our reading together through the letter to the Ephesians this month, we will be challenged as the apostle Paul admonishes believers to imitate God in all things, to live a life of love and to follow after the example of Jesus, whose sacrificial example serves as a model for our own lives. As we do, every area of our lives will be affected, our family life, our conduct in the community, and our sexuality.

We'll discuss what it means to submit to one another, particularly in the marriage relationship. Paul, in talking about Christ's church, draws an analogy from marriage that teaches us much about the sort of relationship that husbands and wives are to share. While it is often emphasized that the wife is to submit to her husband, we must keep this in context with 5:21 which reminds us that we are ALL to submit to one another. This is the posture of the Christian. Similarly, wives are to respect their husbands. Instruction for Children and parents follows. Indeed, the gospel should affect all of our relationships, even the relationship well known in Paul's day between a slave and his master.

Finally, in a beautifully worded conclusion,
Paul exhorts us to put on the full armor of
God! Talk about what it means to arm ourselves with the armor he describes and about
what it means to be attacked by the "devil's
schemes." Share together, laugh together and
enjoy being together. Next month, we will be
kicking off a new season of small groups and I
encourage you to be in prayer about what
group the Lord would have you be a part of or
how you might continue in this group. Blessings!
